

Sedgwick Club Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM)

Purpose of EGM: to pass three amendments to the club constitution.

Motion 1

Committee members must wear the newly defined 'Official Club Dress' at any future EGM. This is to be a university gown with gaiters.

Motion is passed with 13 votes for and 1 against.

Motion 2

The current constitution requires that the committee must invite all living members of the Sedgwick Club when they choose to hold an EGM. The current committee propose that this be changed to those club members who are 'current active members of the University of Cambridge, and others who have left their contact details'.

Motion is passed with a 14-0 unanimous majority.

Motion 3

Committee propose that all committee members have the right to be signatories on a Sedgwick Club debit card, so that they may make purchases and payments on behalf of the Sedgwick Club.

Motion is passed with 13 positive votes and one abstention.
